Its subject and tone need to be distinctive, yet it needs also to be professional and polite. You need not try to be flamboyant or dramatic, but you do need to be yourself – your best professional self. As you pan your essay you lust keep your readers in ind they are usy professionals self out their jo sand their careers they value honest clear interesting riting they can spot B S quick y and as they read through those stacks of essays they are looking not for the right ans ers ut for the right people

App ications rare y specify as topic Instead they ask for an epanation of hy you ant to go to graduate school or for an indication of your career plans. Most essays ask for a response to this question "Why do you want to do this?" As you settle on a topic you again need to e concerned that you don't rite a out the sale thing in the sale ords that everyone else i rite a out

Be sure you rite ith a thesis you need to focus quite narro y on your topic not ander through a ho e ist of ideas. You ust try to deve op a single central idea in the essay. Stay ithin the ength guide ines usually ords save your energy for your thesis or dissertation.
